1	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) seeks to enter into a
2	Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Border Anti-Narcotics Network
3	(BANN); and
4	WHEREAS, the MOU Agreement is for the purpose of combating smuggling operations of
5	individuals and organizations throughout an area that encompasses 150 miles of
6	international border; and
7	WHEREAS, the purpose of BANN is to reduce drug trafficking and related crimes by dismantling
8	and disrupting smuggling operations; and
9	WHEREAS, this agreement will be effective upon signature of official authorized signature of each
10	participating agency; and
11	WHEREAS, this MOU may be amended, modified or reviewed in writing and such amendment,
12	modification or revision with the signature of an authorized official of each
13	participating agency; and
14	WHEREAS, the attached MOU has been reviewed by the Domestic Affairs Committee which
15	recommends Legislative Council approval.
16	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
17	approves this Memorandum of Understanding with the Border Anti-Narcotics Network
18	(BANN) as attached hereto.

20	Chairman and the Nation's Police Department to fully implement the MOU provided
21	that any amendments shall be submitted for approval by the Tohono O'odham
