

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Memorandum of Understanding between the Tohono O'odham
Nation Police Department and the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and
Explosives associated with the Project Safe Neighborhoods)

RESOLUTION NO. 10-381

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) is requesting to enter into**
2 **a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco,**
3 **Firearms and Explosives (ATF) to establish an efficient and cohesive unit capable of**
4 **addressing violent crime and maximize interagency cooperation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the mission of this program is for participating agencies to conduct in-depth**
6 **investigations of firearms related crimes, to identify and target for prosecution the**
7 **perpetrators of such crimes (i.e. criminal street gangs, armed career criminals,**
8 **firearms traffickers, and armed narcotics traffickers); and**

9 **WHEREAS, this agreement will be effective upon signature of official authorized signature of each**
10 **participating agency; and**

11 **WHEREAS, this MOU may be amended, modified or reviewed in writing and such amendment,**
12 **modification or revision with the signature of an authorized official of each**
13 **participating agency.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
15 **accepts the Memorandum of Understanding for the Tohono O'odham Nation Police**
16 **Department with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives as attached**
17 **hereto.**

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**
19 **Chairman of the Nation to sign and execute the MOU with the Bureau of Alcohol,**
20 **Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives provided that any amendments shall be submitted**
21 **for approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16TH Day**
23 **of SEPTEMBER, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,408.40 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 187.10[05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
25 **by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
26 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
28 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
