**RESOLUTION NO. 10-382**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department (TONPD) seeks to enter into a**  
2 **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Federal Bureau of Investigation**  
3 **and State, Local, Tribal, and Federal Agencies participating in the Law Enforcement**  
4 **National Data Exchange (N-DEX) Information Sharing Initiative thru the Federal**  
5 **Bureau of Investigations; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the MOU Agreement is for the purpose of sharing information with all State, Local,**  
7 **Tribal and Federal agencies in regards to criminal activities; and**

8 **WHEREAS, this will give TOPD access to information related to criminal activities, leads on**  
9 **investigation on open cases, threat levels on person or persons that are on the Nation**  
10 **tribally or non tribal; and**

11 **WHEREAS, this agreement will be effective upon signature of official authorized signature of each**  
12 **participating agency; and**

13 **WHEREAS, this MOU may be amended, modified or reviewed in writing and such amendment,**  
14 **modification or revision with the signature of an authorized official of each**  
15 **participating agency; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the attached MOU has been reviewed by the Domestic Affairs Committee which**  
17 **recommends Legislative Council approval.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
19 **approves this Memorandum of Understanding with the Federal Bureau of**  
20 **Investigation and State, Local, Tribal and Federal Agencies participating in the Law**  
21 **Enforcement National Data Exchange Information Sharing Initiative as attached**  
22 **hereto.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**  
24 **Chairman and the Nation's Police Department to fully implement the MOU provided**  
25 **that any amendments shall be submitted for approval by the Tohono O'odham**  
26 **Legislative Council.**
