

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Grant Agreement No. 04-10-NA-649d with the United States Department of the
Interior-National Park Service that Provides Funding for the Tohono O'odham Nation's
Tribal Historic Preservation Office and the Creation of a Cultural Affairs Tribal
Historic Preservation Office Account and Budget for FY 2010-2011)**

RESOLUTION NO. 10-396

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the need to protect, preserve and manage**
2 **cultural resources on its lands; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council established the Cultural Affairs Program in**
4 **1997; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed Resolution 08-249, "Approving**
6 **Application for the Tohono O'odham Nation (TON) to establish a Tribal Historic**
7 **Preservation Office (THPO) as part of the TON's Cultural Affairs Program" to provide**
8 **Section 106 Compliance under National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (NHP)(16**
9 **U.S.C. 470) for the protection and preservation of archaeological resources historically**
10 **associated with traditional or sacred values and beliefs important to the O'odham,**
11 **and of the physical site, location or context in which archaeological resources are**
12 **found; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation signed a Memorandum of Agreement**
14 **with the United States National Park Service on August 7, 2009 for the Assumption by**
15 **the TON of certain responsibilities pursuant to the NHP (16 U.S.C. 470); and**

16 **WHEREAS, the TON received notification from the United States National Park Service on**
17 **September 4, 2009, that the TON THPO Office application was approved; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the TON received notification from the United States National Park Service on March**
19 **9, 2010 that the budget for the TON THPO Office was approved at a level of \$95,024.00**
20 **for FY 2010-2011 (see attached budget sheet).**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
22 **approve Grant Agreement No. 04-10-NA-649d, in substantially the form attached**
23 **hereto, with the United States National Park Service, Washington, D.C. and authorizes:**

- 24 **1. The Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to sign Grant Agreement No. 04-10-**
25 **NA-649d with the National Park Service and any other associated documents.**
- 26 **2. The establishment of a Tribal Historic Preservation Office account for the Cultural**
27 **Affairs program.**

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
1 3. The Cultural Affairs Program to expend funds in this Tribal Historic Preservation
2 Account for operational purposes consistent with approved budgets.

3 4. A carryover of funds provided by the National Park Service for the Tohono
4 O'odham Tribal Historic Preservation Office for each succeeding fiscal year.

5 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
6 Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as
7 attached, provided however that any amendments affecting the funds or funding
8 levels shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham legislative
9 Council.

10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29TH Day
11 of SEPTEMBER, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,271.85 FOR; 93.55
12 AGAINST; 230.10[03] NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
13 by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
14 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
15 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
16 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
