

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2011 - Title III B, C-1, C-2, E; Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP)
and Accepting the New State Fund Budget July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 Account
No.: 13-1421; 13-1422; 13-1432; 13-1434; 13-1425 and New State Funds Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 10-414

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated the Senior Services program**
2 **for the Elders of the Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 for the operation of the Senior**
4 **Services Program is possible in part by Title III of the Older Americans Act funds**
5 **administered through the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona (ITCA); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the services provided to the Elders and Caregivers are beneficial and services continue**
7 **to be necessary in order to provide nutrition and transportation support to the Elders;**
8 **and Caregiver support to Caregivers of Elders and Elders raising Grandchildren; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the fiscal Year 2011 Title III-B \$27,961.00; C-1 \$87,420.00; C-2 \$42,845.00 program**
10 **budgets were prepared to continue nutrition, socialization and transportation**
11 **services to eligible Elders; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the fiscal Year 2011 Title III E \$32,443.00 budget was prepared to provide support**
13 **services to current and potential Caregivers who provide care services for Elders and**
14 **to Elders who care for grandchildren; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the fiscal Year 2011 Title III Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) \$7,219.00**
16 **budget was prepared to provide nutrition services to eligible Elders; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the new State Funds \$20,737.00 budget was prepared to support the Title III B; Title III**
18 **C-1 and Title III C-2 budgets for the Congregate Meals; Home Delivered Meals and**
19 **Transportation services.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
21 **approves:**

- 22 **1. The fiscal Year 2011 (retro active to July 1, 2010) Title III-B \$27,961.00; C-1**
23 **\$87,420.00; C-2 \$42,845.00 program budgets to continue nutrition, socialization**
24 **and transportation services to eligible Elders.**
- 25 **2. The fiscal Year 2011 (retro active to July 1, 2010) Title III E \$32,443.00 budget to**
26 **continue to provide support services to current and potential Caregivers who**
27 **provide care services for Elders and to Elders who care for grandchildren.**

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1 3. The fiscal Year 2011 (retro active to July 1, 2010) Title III Nutrition Services
2 Incentive Program (NSIP) budget of \$7,219.00 to continue to provide nutrition
3 services to eligible Elders.

4 4. To accepts the recurring State Funds budget in the amount of \$20,737.00 to support
5 the Title III B; Title III C-1 and Title III C-2 budgets for Congregate Meal; Home
6 Delivered Meal and Transportation services.

7 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation officials to wit, the Chairman, Vice-**
8 **Chairman, and any designated official is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute**
9 **the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding**
10 **levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

11 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day**
12 **of OCTOBER, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,501.95 FOR; 93.55**
13 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
14 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
15 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
16 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
17 **Stat. 984).**
