RESOLUTION NO. 10-434

1	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation seeks to apply for Indian Community Development Block
2	Grant ("ICDBG") funding available through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urbar
3	Development ("HUD"); and
4	WHEREAS, to receive an award of funds from HUD, an applicant is required to submit a Code of
5	Conduct establishing minimum standards of conduct governing officials, employees
6	and agents engaged in the award and administration of grants and contracts
7	supported by federal funds; and
8	WHEREAS, the required Code of Conduct must (1) prohibit real and apparent conflicts of interest
9	that may arise among officials, employees, or agents; (2) prohibit solicitation and
10	acceptance of gifts or gratuities by officials, employees or agents for their personal
11	benefit; (3) outline administrative and disciplinary actions available to remedy
12	violations of such standards; and (4) describe how officials, employees and agents will
13	be made aware of the Code of Conduct; and
14	WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared a Code of Conduct
15	for HUD Grant Programs of the Tohono O'odham Nation (attached hereto) that meets
16	the requirements of HUD; and
17	WHEREAS, the Code of Conduct has been reviewed and approved by the Rules and Budget and
18	Finance Committees which recommend approval by the Legislative Council.
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
20	1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and enacts the Nation's Code of
21	Conduct substantially in the form attached hereto.
22	2. This Code of Conduct shall apply to all HUD Grant Programs administered by any
23	department or Branch of the Tohono O'odham Nation.
24	3. In the event that this Code of Conduct conflicts with other policies or procedures of
25	$the {\it Nation}, this {\it Code} of {\it Conductshallgovern} any HUD Grant Program of the Nation.$
