6		of \$260,000.00 and modification no. 125 in the amount of \$35,623.00 for the total				
7		increase of \$414,257.00; and				
8	WHEREAS,	the TONPD Corrections Program has added a new line item 810 Professional Services				
9		by adding the amount of \$260,000.00 as stated in modification no. 124 for contract				
10		beds as needed until all funds are expended and added an additional \$30,000.00 as				
11		needed for other services for a total increase of \$290,000.00; and				
12	WHEREAS,	TONPD Corrections Program also increase line items 710 Utilities by adding \$32,384,				
13		line 770 Repair and Maintenance of Equipment by adding \$40,000 and 722 Program				
14		Supplies adding \$35,623; and				
15	WHEREAS,	the TONPD Corrections Program has added new line items 650 Tuition and				
16		Registration,655 Lodging, 660 Travel Expenses, 721 Supplies other, for a total as				
17		noted on the attached Budget; and				
18	WHEREAS,	with this increase the Indirect cost has increase by \$20,900.03; and				
19	WHEREAS,	the amount of \$260,000.00 will retro to October 1, 2010 to cover the cost of Contract				
20	:	beds.				
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
