

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving carry forward of FY 2010 budget for the Community Oriented Policing
Services (COPS) Hiring Program Grant (CHRP) Grant)

RESOLUTION NO. 10-473

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department received and accepted a three year**
2 **grant award for \$622,710 from the FY 2009 Recovery Act (ARRA) COPS Hiring Recovery**
3 **Program per resolution of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council No. 09-887 on**
4 **November 17, 2009; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 09-587 also approved the FY**
6 **2010 budget for year one entry level funding for the period of July 1, 2009 thru June**
7 **30, 2010 in the amount of \$184,535.33; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department hired all three (3) entry-level police officers**
9 **as of January 4, 2010, and from this point begins the entry -level budget period of 12**
10 **months per the grant guidance; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the FY 2010 approved entry-level budget is required to be carry forwarded from July**
12 **1, 2010 through December 31, 2010 in order to complete the first year of entry level**
13 **funding for the three police officers; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the attached FY 2011 budget has been reviewed and approved for the period of July**
15 **1, 2010 through December 31, 2010 by the budget office, Grants & Contracts,**
16 **Executive, Domestic Affairs and Budget & Finance and recommends approval.**

17 **WHEREAS, the budget only covers the cost of salary and fringe benefits which the budget does**
18 **reflect salaries for three (3) Police Officer positions that are currently filled.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
20 **approves and authorizes the carry forward of the FY 2010 budget for the period of July**
21 **1, 2009 through December 31, 2010 for the FY 2009 Recovery, COPS Hiring Recovery**
22 **Program (CHRP).**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes the**
24 **Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
25 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level shall**
26 **be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
28 **of DECEMBER, 2010 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,595.50 FOR; -0-**
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article**
30 **VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
33 **Stat. 984).**
