

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing Tohono O'odham Nation Delegation to the National Congress of
American Indians)**

RESOLUTION NO. 15-040

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult with**
2 **the federal government and other Indian tribes on all matters within the**
3 **Council's authority (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI,**
4 **Section 1(f)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is a long-standing member of the National Congress**
6 **of American Indians ("NCAI"), which convenes three times annually at its**
7 **executive council winter session, mid-year conference, and annual convention;**
8 **and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation for many years has worked closely with the NCAI**
10 **and with Native American tribes across the United States to address numerous**
11 **national issues of importance to American Indian people; and**

12 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue its national-**
13 **level involvement in these issues by participating in these NCAI events.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it**
15 **authorizes Nation's Chairman Ned Norris, Jr. to serve as the Nation's voting**
16 **delegate and Legislative Council Chairman Timothy Joaquin to serve as the**
17 **Nation's alternate voting delegate to the NCAI's executive council winter session,**
18 **mid-year conference, and annual convention; provided that the voting delegate,**
19 **alternate, and any Legislative Council representatives attending NCAI events are**
20 **authorized to present and advocate for resolutions and positions previously**
21 **approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH**
23 **day of FEBRUARY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR;**
24 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
26 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
28 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
