1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation is entitled to receive 66,000 acre-feet of Central
2		Arizona Project ("CAP") water per year under the terms of the Southern Arizona
3		Water Rights Settlement Act, as amended, Title III of Public Law 108-451
4		("SAWRSA"), and in addition is entitled to receive 8,000 acre-feet per year of CAP
5		water per year under the terms of a water delivery contract with the Department
6		of the Interior entered into on December 11, 1980 and amended on May 5, 2006,
7		for a total of 74,000 acre-feet of CAP water per year; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Nation has been storing certain amounts of its 66,000 acre-foot SAWRSA
9		entitlement underground in the Phoenix and Tucson Active Management Areas
10		pursuant to agreements with entities holding storage facility permits issued
11		pursuant to Arizona law; and
12	WHEREAS,	due to drought in the Colorado River basin and other factors, the flows of the
13		Colorado River have been reduced and the water levels in Lake Mead and Lake
14		Powell have decreased to levels not seen since the filling of those reservoirs; and
15	WHEREAS,	to counteract the declining water levels in Lake Mead, the United States Bureau
16		of Reclamation, the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, the
17		Central Arizona Water Conservation District, the Southern Nevada Water
18		Authority, and Denver Water have entered into an agreement to fund up to \$11
19		million to compensate water using entities such as the Nation for reducing their
20		use of Colorado River water and thereby retaining water in Lake Mead under a
21		program entitled the Lake Mead Pilot System Conservation Program; and
22	WHEREAS,	to participate in the Lake Mead Pilot System Conservation Program, the Water
23		Resources Committee of the Legislative Council has developed a Tohono
24		O'odham Nation pre-proposal for submittal to the Bureau of Reclamation for
25		use in 2015; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed this proposal and
27		recommends approval by the Legislative Council.
28	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves
29		the Tohono O'odham Nation Pre-Proposal for the Lake Mead Pilot System
30		Conservation Program for the year 2015 substantially in the form attached

hereto, and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to promptly deliver the
document to the Bureau of Reclamation.
