**(Approving Amendment 1 to the Water Resources Department FY15 BIA Budget**  
**to add FY14 BIA carry-forward funds)**

RESOLUTION NO. 15-061

1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the Water Resources**  
2                   **Department FY15 EPA budget through Resolution 14-348; and**

3   **WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office has identified FY14 BIA carry-forward funds, in**  
4                   **the amount of \$7,665.58; and**

5   **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department is requesting the approval of Amendment 1 to**  
6                   **include the carry-forward amount and increase the 7355 Professional Services**  
7                   **line item and indirect cost; and**


8   **WHEREAS, the Water Resources and the Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative**  
9                   **Council have reviewed this Amendment and recommend its approval.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
11                   **approves Amendment 1 to the Water Resources Department FY15 BIA budget to**  
12                   **add FY14 BIA carry-forward funds, in the amount of \$7,665.58 to operational and**  
13                   **\$260.14 to the indirect cost, increasing the budget from \$117,761.93 to**  
14                   **\$125,687.65.**

15 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
16                   **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget,**  
17                   **as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding**  
18                   **levels is submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**  
19                   **Legislative Council.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04<sup>TH</sup>**  
21 **day of MARCH, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR; -0-**  
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
23 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(3) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**  
24 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
25 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
26 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


