

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Setting March 31, 2015 to Address "Upholding Integrity in Tribal Leadership: Felony
Disqualification Referendum")**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 15-067

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to establish rules and**
2 **procedures to regulate all meetings of the Tohono O'odham Council, standing**
3 **committees, boards and special committees." (Constitution of the Tohono**
4 **O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council vests the**
6 **Council with the authority to "by majority vote, call for a special session"**
7 **(Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, Article I, Section**
8 **1.D.1.); and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Rules Committee requests a March 31, 2015 special session to address the**
10 **"Upholding Integrity in Tribal Leadership: Felony Disqualification**
11 **Referendum."**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it sets a**
13 **special session on March 31, 2015 to address the "Upholding Integrity in Tribal**
14 **Leadership: Felony Disqualification Referendum."**

15 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05TH day of**
16 **MARCH, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946.5 FOR; -0-**
17 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
18 **Article VI, Section 1(a) and Article XIV of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
19 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
20 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**
21 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
