

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2015 Johnson O'Malley Budget Amendment #1 for FY 2014 Carry Forward)

RESOLUTION NO. 15-082

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Department of Education Johnson**
2 **O'Malley Program has successfully provided needed services and assistance to**
3 **eligible Tohono O'odham children and other Native American children enrolled**
4 **in Baboquivari Unified School District, Gila Bend Unified School District, and**
5 **Division of Early Childhood Development schools; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved FY 2015 Johnson O'Malley**
7 **Program (JOM) Budget by Resolution 14-348; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office has identified a carry forward savings for the**
9 **JOM Program increasing the total budget amount and Indirect Cost amount;**
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, a budget amendment has been prepared and submitted for approval; and**

12 **WHEREAS, Amendment #1 allows the creation of new line items 6520 Per Diem, 6530**
13 **Transportation, 7355 Professional Services and 7500 Major Capital; and**

14 **WHEREAS, Budget Amendment #1 will allow the increases of Operational line items and the**
15 **decrease of 6205 Employer Health; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and the Budget and Finance Committees of**
17 **the Legislative Council have reviewed this budget and recommend its approval.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
19 **approve the FY 2015 Johnson O'Malley Budget Amendment #1 to:**

- 20 1. **Approve adding Identifying Carry-over amount in the amount of**
21 **\$258,607.57.**
- 22 2. **Approve the increase to Operational line items and the decrease to**
23 **Personnel Expense line item.**
- 24 3. **Approve the creating of new Operational line items.**
- 25 4. **Approve the increase to the total budget to \$408,651.63.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
27 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
28 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
29 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
30 **Council.**
