

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Higher Education Services Program FY 2015 Budget Amendment #1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-083**

1   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation through the Higher Education Services Program**  
2                   **has been successfully providing counseling and financial assistance to eligible**  
3                   **Tohono O'odham to attend post-secondary institutes; and**  
4   **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved FY 2015 Higher Education**  
5                   **Services Program Budget by Resolution 14-348; and**  
6   **WHEREAS, the Grants and Contracts Office has identified a carry forward savings and a**  
7                   **budget amendment has been submitted for review and approval; and**  
8   **WHEREAS, Amendment #1 will allow the increase and decrease of Operational Expense and**  
9                   **decrease of a personnel Expense line items; and**  
10   **WHEREAS, increasing the Indirect Cost amount; and**  
11   **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and the Budget and Finance Committees of**  
12                   **the Legislative Council have reviewed this budget and recommend its approval.**

13   **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves**  
14                   **the Higher Education Services Program Budget Amendment #1 as follows:**

- 15           1.    **Approve adding identified Carry-Forward Savings in the amount of**  
16                   **\$520,887.36.**
- 17           2.    **Approve the increase and decrease of Operational Expense.**
- 18           3.    **Approve the decrease of Personnel Expense line item.**
- 19           4.    **Approve increasing the IDC and increasing the total budget to**  
20                   **\$1,310,919.00.**

21   **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
22                   **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
23                   **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**  
24                   **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
25                   **Council.**

26   **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup>**  
27   **day of APRIL, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,946,5 FOR; -0-**  
28   **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29   **Article VI, Section 1(d)(3) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**  
30   **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
31   **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
32   **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
