

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving Amendment #1 to the FY 2015 Bureau of Indian Affairs Law Enforcement**  
**P.L. 93-638 budget to include the FY 2014 carry forward savings)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-131**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation contracts its own Law Enforcement, Ranger and**  
2 **Corrections Programs under the 638 BIA Master Contract; and**  
3 **WHEREAS, the FY 2015 638 Law Enforcement budget was approved by Tohono O'odham**  
4 **Legislative Council through Resolution No. 14-348; and**  
5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department carry forward savings has been**  
6 **identified; and**  
7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department has submitted an amendment**  
8 **for its FY 2015 638 Law Enforcement budget; and**  
9 **WHEREAS, amendment #1 allows the creating of new line items 7050 Firearms & Tasers,**  
10 **7100 Utilities, 7340 Public Relations, 7410 RM Vehicle, 7420 RM Building, 7500**  
11 **Major Capital and 8060 Alternations and Renovations; and**  
12 **WHEREAS, the amendment will increase the Operational Expense line items and the**  
13 **Personnel Expense line items; and**  
14 **WHEREAS, this amendment will increase the budget and the Indirect Cost amount; and**  
15 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative**  
16 **Council have reviewed this budget and recommends its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
18 **approves Budget Amendment No. 1 for 638 Law Enforcement to:**

- 19 **1. Approve the increasing and creating of new Operational Expense line**  
20 **items and increasing Personnel Expense line items.**
- 21 **2. Approve increasing budget amount to \$6,320,276.41 and increasing**  
22 **Indirect Cost to \$949,937.82.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes**  
24 **the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the**  
25 **budget as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or**  
26 **funding level is submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**  
27 **Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05<sup>TH</sup>**  
29 **day of MAY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,926,9 FOR; -0-**  
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(3) and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**  
32 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
33 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
34 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
