3 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Senior Services Division is possible in part with**
4 **funding from Title VI of the Older Americans Act of 1978 as amended and**
5 **administered by the Administration of Aging; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the funding is necessary for continuation of nutrition and socialization services**
7 **that are provided to eligible Elders; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Senior Services Division is requesting approval for the FY 2016 Title VI Part**
9 **A, Part C and Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP) budgets for period**
10 **April 1, 2015 to March 31, 2016**

17 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and the Budget and Finance Committees of the**
18 **Legislative Council have reviewed the budgets and recommend its approval.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
20 **approves the FY2016 Title VI Part A \$156,070.00, Part C \$45,900.00 and Nutrition**
21 **Services Incentive Program (NSIP) \$3,527.00 budgets for the period April 1, 2015**
22 **to March 31, 2016 and to utilize the Nation's resources pending reimbursement**
23 **from the Grantor for continuation of the grant.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
25 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
26 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
27 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
28 **Council.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH**
30 **day of MAY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,926.9 FOR; -0-**
31 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
32 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)and(j) and of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**
33 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
34 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
35 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**






