

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approval of West Valley Department of Information & Technology Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-161**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has begun the process of building and establishing**  
2 **the new West Valley Casino and Resort; and**

3 **WHEREAS, with this new Casino and Resort the Tohono O'odham Nation will need**  
4 **assistance from the Department of Information & Technology to provide**  
5 **services to the Nation with new and emerging technology that will provide**  
6 **connectivity, support and communication for Nation programs; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Information & Technology has created an FY 2015 budget**  
8 **which has been reviewed by the Executive Office, and the Budget and Finance**  
9 **Committee of the Legislative Council and recommends is approval.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**  
11 **approves the FY 2015 Department of Information & Technology West Valley**  
12 **Resort budget in the amount of \$389,721.92 to be appropriated from the general**  
13 **fund.**

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the general fund shall be reimbursed this amount from the**  
15 **Judgment Funds as approved by Resolution #15-127.**

16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Information & Technology West Valley**  
17 **Resort budget that any funds unexpended will automatically be forwarded to the**  
18 **next budget year and the Department of Information & Technology will seek**  
19 **additional funds for the continuation of the operation.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes**  
21 **the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the**  
22 **budget as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or**  
23 **funding level shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono**  
24 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup>**  
26 **day of MAY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,926.9 FOR; -0-**  
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
29 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**  
31 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
