

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services,
Division of Community Health Services, Public Health Emergency Preparedness
and Response (PHEP) -Bioterrorism (BT) FY 2016 Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 15-177

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is concerned with the health, welfare and safety of**
2 **its members who reside on or near the Tohono O'odham Nation Reservation,**
3 **including the O'odham in Mexico; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation entered into a fixed price Intergovernmental**
5 **Agreement (IGA) #ADHS11-005790 approved via TOLC Resolution #10-478 with**
6 **the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS) for Public Health**
7 **Preparedness and Response for Bioterrorism; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the granting agency has awarded the project period for a five-year period**
9 **beginning September 1, 2010 to August 31, 2015 and the Public Health**
10 **Emergency Preparedness and Response (PHEP) – Bioterrorism program has**
11 **prepared a budget to expend funds for the budget period to provide continued**
12 **services; and**

13 **WHEREAS, IGA agreement #4 dated March 14, 2014 and approved by Tohono O'odham**
14 **Legislative Council Resolution #14-041, was issued by ADHS to reflect current**
15 **year budget period of July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Center for Disease Control award stipulates a 10% match requirement which**
17 **will be met through cost share of the Public Health Preparedness Coordinator**
18 **salary with Division of Community Health; and**

19 **WHEREAS, ADHS Fiscal Year 2016 BT budget is prepared in the amount of \$62,492.17,**
20 **which represents carry over funds from #ADHS11-005790 contract for project**
21 **period from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016 and also includes the Tohono O'odham**
22 **Nation's federally approved indirect cost rate of 20.41%; and**

23 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have**
24 **reviewed the FY16 BT budget and recommend its approval.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby:**

- 26 **1. Approves the FY2016 Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) –**
27 **Bioterrorism (BT) budget in the amount of \$62,492.17 for a period of**
28 **July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016.**
- 29 **2. Approves the 10% match requirement which will be met through cost**
30 **share of the Public Health Preparedness Coordinator salary with**
31 **Community Health.**

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1 3. **Authorizes the Nation to obligate and expend funds upon approval of this**
2 **resolution and to utilize the Nation's resources pending reimbursement**
3 **from the Grantor for the continuation of this Grant.**

4 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Public Health Emergency Preparedness program budget is**
5 **authorized to utilize funding for the project period ending August 31, 2015 or**
6 **until the grant funds are fully expended to provide continued services.**

7 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
8 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
9 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level**
10 **shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
11 **Council.**

12 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH**
13 **day of MAY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,926.9 FOR; -0-**
14 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
15 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
16 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
17 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
18 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
