

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 2016 U.S. Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Education
Sovereignty in Indian Education Grant (SIE) Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 15-188

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Education Department's primary goal is to revise**
2 **and update the 1982 Comprehensive Education Plan with a focused study on BIE**
3 **funded schools in the area of school reform; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Education has awarded the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Nation the Sovereignty in Indian Education Grant to develop a**
6 **plan that will support the development of a plan to improve educational**
7 **outcomes for students and improve the efficiency and effectiveness in BIE**
8 **funded schools; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and the Budget and Finance Committees of**
10 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and**
11 **recommend its approval.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves**
13 **the FY 2016 U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian Education SIE**
14 **Grant Budget in the amount of \$200,000.00.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Education is**
16 **authorized to expend the funds from this grant in accordance with the terms**
17 **and conditions of the U.S. Department of the Interior, Bureau of Indian**
18 **Education Sovereignty in Indian Education Grant Program from October 1, 2015**
19 **to September 30, 2016.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes**
21 **the Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the**
22 **budget as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or**
23 **funding level is submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 20TH**
26 **day of MAY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,752.7 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 174.2[07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
28 **by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
31 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
