

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2016 Rodeo and Fair Budget combining General Fund,
Sponsorships & Contributions and Program Revenue)

RESOLUTION NO. 15-196

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Rodeo and Fair Office has coordinated the Nation's**
2 **annual rodeo and fair and related events held under the supervision of the**
3 **Department of Natural Resources with funds authorized and appropriated by**
4 **the Nation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, funding appropriated by the Nation provides a funding base for which the Rodeo**
6 **and Fair Office operates the annual event; and**

7 **WHEREAS, sponsorships and contributions to supplement the rodeo and fair events have**
8 **been solicited and such monies provide not only funding support for the rodeo**
9 **and fair events but also are of benefit to the businesses and organizations**
10 **providing sponsorship and contributions as it provides advertising and public**
11 **relations value; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Rodeo and Fair Office has prepared a FY 2016 budget combining program**
13 **revenue, sponsorship & contribution dollars and general fund dollars for better**
14 **budget management; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Natural Resources and the Budget and Finance Committees**
16 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its**
17 **approval.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes**
19 **the expenditure of \$307,132.14 which is a combination of \$80,000 from Rodeo &**
20 **Fair Program Revenue, \$25,000 from Sponsorships and Contributions and**
21 **\$202,132.14 from the General Fund per Resolution #15-165 for a Budget period**
22 **of October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
24 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
25 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
26 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
27 **Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21ST**
29 **day of MAY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,926.9 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
32 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
34 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
