12	WHEREAS,	the Rodeo and Fair Office has prepared a FY 2016 budget combining program	
13		revenue, sponsorship & contribution dollars and general fund dollars for better	
14		budget management; and	
15	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources and the Budget and Finance Committees	
16		of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its	
17		approval.
