

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving and Authorizing KOHN's FY 2016 CPB CSG Budget, waiver of Indirect
Costs and Authorizing the Recognition of Indirect Administrative Support for
KOHN FM as Additional Non-Federal Financial Support)**

RESOLUTION NO. 15-205

1 **WHEREAS, KOHN 91.9 FM was licensed to begin broadcast on December 23, 2005 and**
2 **completed its first year of on-air broadcast on December 23, 2006, thereby**
3 **becoming eligible for a Community Service Grant (CSG) from the Corporation for**
4 **Public Broadcasting (CPB); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the CSG is a single grant program consisting of several levels of qualification,**
6 **each level having specific requirements that determine the amount of funding**
7 **that an eligible grantee will be awarded. CPB determines the appropriate CSG**
8 **funding level based on the information provided by the applicant; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the CPB requires that all applicants spent a portion of CSG funding on costs**
10 **relating to the acquisition or production of national programming; and**

11 **WHEREAS, CSG funding is restricted to operational support of KOHN's radio broadcast**
12 **operations and does not provide for administrative cost rates normally applied**
13 **to grants as indirect cost, therefore making it necessary that the established**
14 **indirect cost rate of the nation be waived for this grant; and**

15 **WHEREAS, CPB does permit the Nation to record and report the total calculated**
16 **administrative support costs provided to KOHN as additional Non Federal**
17 **Financial Support; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has received notice from CPB that KOHN will**
19 **continue to be funded at similar levels for succeeding fiscal years so long as it**
20 **maintains its eligibility; and**

21 **WHEREAS, each grant award has an expenditure period of two years, the 2016 grant amount**
22 **will have a grant period of October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2017, however,**
23 **KOHN budgets the full amount for the current fiscal year of October 1, 2015**
24 **through September 30, 2016; and**

25 **WHEREAS, KOHN has prepared and submitted for review by the Executive Branch, Culture**
26 **Preservation and the Budget and Finance Committees the attached budget, in**
27 **the amount of \$265,116.81 which includes the estimated indirect cost support of**
28 **\$37,480.23 to facilitate the expenditure of the grant.**

29 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
30 **approves the waiver of Indirect Costs as required of the grant, provided however**
31 **that the Nation shall record and report the indirect administrative support**
32 **provided to KOHN as additional Non-federal financial support as permitted by**
33 **CPB.**

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1 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the attached
2 budget, in the amount of \$265,116.81 including the estimate of the indirect cost
3 of \$37,480.23, is approved and authorized to be expended for the purposes
4 described effective fiscal year October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2016.

5 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Nation is
6 authorized to record and report the indirect administrative support provided to
7 KOHN for the purpose of recognizing such costs as additional Non-federal
8 financial support as permitted by CPB.

9 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the
10 Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as
11 attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding level is
12 submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
13 Council.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21ST
15 day of MAY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,926.9 FOR; -0-
16 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
17 Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
18 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
19 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
20 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
