RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Authorizing the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association to Submit 2015 Indian Community Development Block Grant Program for Mold Remediation & Prevention and New Construction Housing Applications to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development)

RESOLUTION NO. 15-214

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council
2		with the power to enact laws "to promote, protect and provide for public health,
3		peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation
4		and its members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association ("TOKA") is the Nation's tribally
6		designated housing entity in accordance with the Native American Housing
7		Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996, 25 U.S.C. § 4101, et seq., P.L. 104-
8		330, 110 Stat. 4106 ("NAHASDA") and is authorized to receive and administer the
9		Indian Housing Block Grant and to seek other funds to operate, maintain, and
10		expand affordable housing; and
11	WHEREAS,	TOKA is a "tribal organization," which has been determined eligible to apply
12		directly for Indian Community Development Block Grant ("ICDBG") funds by the
13		HUD Southwest Office of Native American Programs, provided that the Tohono
14		O'odham Nation authorizes TOKA to do so on its behalf (25 U.S.C. §450b; 24 C.F.R.
15		§1003.5); and
16	WHEREAS,	as confirmed in studies conducted in 2006 by a HUD financed assessment and by
17		the Indian Health Services, the Legislative Council and the TOKA recognize the
18		dire need for mold remediation and prevention in many of the previously HUD
19		financed low-income housing units and a concurrent need for new low-income
20		single-family housing units, and
21	WHEREAS,	the TOKA wishes to address the unhealthy conditions of existing units by
22		submitting a 2015 Mold Remediation and Prevention ICDBG application for
23		\$800,000, which commits to leverage \$650,000 of Indian Housing Block Grant
24		funds to rehabilitate single-family low-income HUD financed housing units; and
25	WHEREAS,	the TOKA wishes to continue providing new affordable housing to meet the
26		needs of the community members by submitting a 2015 ICDBG application for
27		new construction housing in the amount of \$2,750,000, which commits to
28		leverage \$850,000 with Indian Housing Block Grant funds for construction of 15
29 30	MILEDEAC	low-income single-family housing units; and
31	WHEREAS,	the ICDBG regulations at 24 CFR 1003.5 and the ICDBG Mold Notice of Funding
31		Availability require that when a tribal organization submits an application on

behalf of an eligible tribe, the organization must first obtain authorization by resolution from the tribe; and

WHEREAS. the Nation held public meetings to discuss the ICDBC programs for Mold.

the Nation held public meetings to discuss the ICDBG programs for Mold Remediation and New Construction housing eligible activities, including a discussion of the proposed projects, allowed public comments, and made modifications to the applications as necessary in compliance with 24 CFR 1003.604(a); and

WHEREAS, the Nation confirms compliance with Citizen Participation requirements pursuant to 24 CFR 1003.604.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it:

- 1. authorizes the TOKA to submit a FY 2015 application for HUD ICDBG MOLD REMEDIATION & PREVENTION funding in the amount of \$800,000 to rehabilitate low-income HUD financed housing units and agrees to commit leveraging funds in the amount of \$650,000 from the IHBG funds through the FY 2015 Indian Housing Plan; and
- authorizes the TOKA to submit a FY 2015 application for HUD ICDBG NEW CONSTRUCTION funding in the amount of \$2,750,000 and agrees to commit leveraging funds in the amount of \$850,000 from the IHBG funds through the FY 2015 Indian Housing Plan; and
- 3. Confirms the Nation has met and complied with the Citizen Participation requirements of 24 CFR 1003.604.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes and directs the Nation's Chairperson to execute all documents necessary to submit TOKA's FY 2015 applications for HUD ICDBG funds.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 27TH day of MAY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,752.7 FOR; -0-AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and 174.2[02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
