LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Judgment in Contest of 2015 General Election for Sif Oidak District Chairperson and Vice-Chairperson)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 15-219

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation provides that the "Council shall
2		enact an election ordinance which shall prescribe the qualifications of
3		candidates, the registration requirements for voting and such other rules and
4		procedures necessary to the orderly conduct of elections, including but not
5		limited to procedures for validation of petitions and the settlement of any and
6		all election disputes." (Constitution, Article X, Section 7); and
7	WHEREAS,	the "decision of the Tohono O'odham Council in all election matters, including
8		the eligibility and qualifications of candidates, shall be final." (Constitution,
9		Article X, Section 7); and
10	WHEREAS,	Article IX of 12 T.O.C. Chapter 1 – Elections, establishes the procedure for "any
11		eligible voter of the Nation" to contest an election upon specific grounds,
12		including "for misconduct on the part of any district election board or of the
13		Board, or any member thereof" (12 T.O.C. Chapter 1 – Elections, Section 1901(A));
14		and
15	WHEREAS,	when "a contest statement is filed with the Board alleging misconduct on the
16		part of the Board or any member thereof," the Legislative Council has
17		jurisdiction to hear the contest (Elections, Section 1904); and
18	WHEREAS,	the Elections law further provides that the "Council will meet within 20 days
19		after the receipt of the answer for the sole purpose of hearing the contest on the
20		grounds of misconduct on the part of the Board or any member thereof and
21		shall decide the issue(s) raised in the contest statement on those grounds only."
22		(Elections, Section 1905(B)); and
23	WHEREAS,	on May 23, 2015, the Election Board conducted the Nation's 2015 general
24		election, including the election for the Sif Oidak District chairperson and vice-
25		chairperson, and the Board posted its certificates of election results on May 24,
26		2015; and
27	WHEREAS,	on May 29, 2015, the Election Board delivered to the Legislative Council
28		secretary a contest statement filed by Nation's voters ("contestors") alleging
29		Election Board misconduct during the May 23, 2015 general election for the Sif
30		Oidak District chairperson and vice-chairperson; and
31	WHEREAS,	on May 29, 2015, the Legislative Council secretary provided written notice
32		requiring the Election Board ("contestee") to file an answer to the contest
33		statement with the secretary within five days of receipt (Elections, Section
34		1905(A)); and

1WHEREAS,on June 2, 2015, the Legislative Council secretary provided both parties with2written notice of the contest hearing date, time, and location and with copies of3the Council's Election Contest Hearing Procedures; and

WHEREAS,on June 3, 2015, the Election Board filed with the Council secretary and providedto the contestors a written answer to the contest statement; and

WHEREAS,the contestors and contestee disclosed to each other and filed with the Councilsecretary exhibits and witness lists prior to the hearing; and

WHEREAS, during the June 8, 2015 contest hearing, the contestors and contestee were represented by legal counsel and were given the opportunity to appear, testify, make opening statements, to call, question, and cross-examine witnesses, present evidence, make objections, make closing statements, and otherwise participate in the hearing; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the hearing the presiding officer ordered a vote to determine whether the election results contested should be certified or set aside in accordance with 12 T.O.C. Chapter 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the May 23, 2015 general election results for the offices of Sif Oidak District chairperson and vice-chairperson are CERTIFIED.

The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the <u>08TH</u> day of <u>JUNE, 2015</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,282.35</u> CERTIFIED; <u>644.55</u> SET ASIDE; and <u>[03]</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article V, Section 1; Article VI, Section 1; Article VI, subsections 1(<u>a), 1(g), and 1(l)</u>; and Article X, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
