RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving a Limited Waiver of the Sovereign Immunity of the Tohono O'odham Gaming Enterprise in favor of Salt River Project)

RESOLUTION NO. 15-236

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") is a federally recognized Indian tribe
2		organized pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18,
3		1934 (48 Stat. 984; 25 U.S.C. § 476), which exercises sovereignty over both its
4		members and its lands; and
5	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Article VI of the Nation's Constitution, the Tohono O'odham
6		Legislative Council (the "Legislative Council") is vested with all of the legislative
7		powers of the Nation and is empowered to enact laws, ordinances, and
8		resolutions necessary or incidental to the exercise of its legislative powers; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council adopted the Charter of the Gaming Enterprise (the
10		"Charter") by Resolution No. 93-311 and amended the Charter by Resolution 02-
11		294, Resolution No. 03-231, and Resolution 04-513 (16 T.O.C. Chapter 2); and
12	WHEREAS,	Section 5(d)(3) of the Charter charges the Gaming Enterprise with the
13		responsibility for planning, constructing, and management of all new or
14		additional gaming facilities; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Management Board is authorized to enter into, make, perform and carry out
16		contracts for any lawful purpose pertaining to the Enterprise's business
17		(Charter, Section 5(d)(10)); and
18	WHEREAS,	Section 8(b)(2) of the Charter provides for a limited waiver of the Gaming
19		Enterprise's sovereign immunity with respect to claims based upon a written
20		contract to which the Gaming Enterprise is a party; and
21	WHEREAS,	the Gaming Enterprise has negotiated a series of agreements with the Salt River
22		Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District ("SRP") to bring electrical
23		services to the buildings being constructed as part of TOGE's development of the
24		West Valley Project near Glendale, Arizona; and
25	WHEREAS,	the agreements include a provision for TOGE and SRP to seek resolution of
26		disputes first through negotiation and, if negotiation fails to resolve the dispute,
27		then through binding arbitration; and

1	WHEREAS,	the agreements also include a provision to permit either party to bring an action
2		against the other party to compel arbitration, enter any judgement of
3		arbitration, or enforce any judgement therefrom in either the Federal District
4		Court in Phoenix, or the State Courts of Arizona in Maricopa County; and
5	WHEREAS,	the provision for arbitration and enforcement of arbitration awards requires a
6		modification of the statutory waiver beyond the parameters of Section 8(b)(2) of
7		the Enterprise's Charter; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Enterprise is seeking approval from the Legislative Council for this
9		modification to the scope of the waiver of the TOGE's immunity pursuant to the
10		terms of its agreements with SRP, which is attached hereto and is incorporated
11		by this reference; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the language
13		of the proposed waiver in favor of SRP and believes it is in the best interest of the
14		Nation to adopt a resolution that approves those modifications; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Nation's best interest will be served by modifying TOGE's statutory waiver of
16	1	sovereign immunity as provided in the attached Exhibit A.
17	NOW, THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council grants a
18		limited waiver of the sovereign immunity of the Tohono O'odham Gaming
19		Enterprise in favor of SRP solely for the purpose of the agreements relating to
20		providing electrical utility services to the West Valley Resort project, and adopts
