

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving an annual Joint Funding Agreement between the United States Geological Survey and the Tohono O'odham Nation to share the cost for the operation of the San Simon Wash stream gage, in the amount of \$8,000)**

RESOLUTION NO. 15-246

1 **WHEREAS, the United States Geological Survey and the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation)**
2 **approved the construction of the San Simon Wash stream gage in December**
3 **1971; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Nation's Water Resources Department uses the San Simon Wash stream gage**
5 **as part of the Nation's Flood Warning System; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the United States Geological Survey and the Nation have negotiated an annual**
7 **Joint Funding Agreement (Agreement) to share the cost for the operation of the**
8 **San Simon Wash stream gage, in the amount of \$8,000 for the United States**
9 **Geological Survey and \$8,000 for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Agreement is in effect from October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Department has included the \$8,000 in its current**
12 **operating FY 2015 SAWRSA budget; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources and the Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative**
14 **Council have reviewed this Agreement and recommend its approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
16 **approves the annual Agreement between the United States Geological Survey**
17 **and the Tohono O'odham Nation to share the cost for the operation of the San**
18 **Simon Wash stream gage, in the amount of \$8,000 for the United States**
19 **Geological Survey and \$8,000 for the Tohono O'odham Nation, substantially in**
20 **the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to sign the**
21 **Agreement on behalf of the Nation.**

22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 6TH**
23 **day of JULY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,015.3 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
25 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
26 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
27 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
28 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
