1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded the U. S. Department of Justice,**
2 **(USDOJ) Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) Technology**
3 **Program Award No. 2010-CK-WX-0333; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has requested a third from the USDOJ/COPS Office**
5 **and was approved for a 12 month no-cost extension for the grant period of June**
6 **16, 2015 through June 15, 2016; and**

7 **WHEREAS, an FY 16 budget has been prepared and submitted for approval; and**

8 **WHEREAS, this grant does not allow for indirect cost; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative**
10 **Council have reviewed this Budget and recommend its approval.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the**
12 **12 month no-cost extension for the U. S. Department of Justice Programs, COPS**
13 **Technology Program Award No. 2010-CK-WX-0333 from June 16, 2015 through**
14 **June 15, 2016.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the FY 2016**
16 **Budget for the U.S. Department of Justice, COPS Technology Program, Grant**
17 **Award No. 2010-CK-WX-0333 and to utilize the Tohono O'odham Nation's**
18 **resources pending reimbursement from the funding agency.**

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
20 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
21 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
22 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
23 **Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH**
25 **day of JULY, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,015.3 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
30 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
