

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Accepting Grant Agreement No. P15AF00210 and Approving the FY 2016 Cultural**  
**Affairs Tribal Historic Preservation Office (THPO) Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 15-295**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") recognizes the need to protect, preserve**  
2 **and manage cultural resources on its lands; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed Resolution 08-249, in part to**  
4 **approve the Nation's application to establish a Tribal Historic Preservation**  
5 **Office ("THPO") as part of the Nation's Cultural Affairs Program, pursuant to the**  
6 **National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 ("NHPA") as amended (16 U.S.C. 470 et.**  
7 **seq.); and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Nation received notification from the National Park Service on June 24, 2015,**  
9 **that its grant application to fund the Nation's THPO Office was approved in the**  
10 **amount of \$77,966.00 for FY 2016; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation and the Budget and Finance Committees of the**  
12 **Legislative Council have reviewed this grant award and budget.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**  
14 **accept the Grant Award of \$77,966.00 from Grant Agreement No. P15AF00210**  
15 **with the United States Department of the Interior, National Park Service and**  
16 **approves the FY 2016 Cultural Affairs Tribal Historic Preservation Office (THPO)**  
17 **Budget as attached and to utilize the Nation's resources pending**  
18 **reimbursement from the grantor for the continuation of the grant.**


19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**  
20 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**  
21 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**  
22 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
23 **Council.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03<sup>RD</sup>**  
25 **day of AUGUST, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,765,7 FOR; -0-**  
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 249.6 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
27 **by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) & (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted**  
28 **by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
29 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
30 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


