7		638 contract, now called the Bureau of Indian Affairs Master Contract ("638				
8		Contract"), to continue the assessment of the Nation's water rights claims under				
9		a program called the Gila River Adjudication Program; and				
10	WHEREAS,	in 2013 and 2014 the Nation was funded by the Bureau of Indian Affairs to				
11		support the Nation's ability to negotiate a settlement of the Nation's water rights				
12		claims; and				
13	WHEREAS,	the Office of Attorney General has prepared a budget for FY 2015 to utilize the				
14		federal funds made available in 2013 and 2014 under the Gila River Adjudication				
15		Program for the consultant subcontract; and				
16	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs, Water Resources and Budget and Finance Committees of				
17		the Legislative Council have reviewed this budget and recommend its approval.				
18	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves					
19		the Office of Attorney General budget for the Gila River Adjudication Program				
20		for FY 2015, to include FY 2014 carry forward savings, to expend Bureau of				
21		Indian Affairs funding in the amount of \$170,000 for a consultant subcontract				
22		under the Gila River Adjudication Program.
