

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving carry forward of unexpended FY 2014 funds into FY 2015 for the
Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department)

RESOLUTION NO. 15-306

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Public Safety Fire Department has**
2 **deemed it critical and necessary to increase Fire Protection services to the**
3 **Tohono O'odham Nation, particularly the San Xavier District, Desert Diamond**
4 **Casino/Hotel and surrounding areas as needed; and**

5 **WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by Resolution No. 07-670 approved a**
6 **request of \$4,055,700.00 for the construction of a permanent fire/police**
7 **substation, aerial ladder truck and other related professional services,**
8 **equipment and training; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the actual construction of the proposed substation will not begin until FY 2015;**
10 **and**

11 **WHEREAS, professional services needs such as architectural and construction**
12 **administration services and site preparation remain; and**

13 **WHEREAS, \$2,854,392.96 was unexpended in the Fire Department Fiscal Year 2014 Capital**
14 **Projects Budget; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative**
16 **Council have reviewed this budget and recommend its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves**
18 **carry forward of unexpended FY 2014 funds in the amount of \$2,854,392.96 into**
19 **FY 2015 to construct a substation and fund other associated needs in accordance**
20 **with the budget attached hereto.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes**
22 **the Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget**
23 **as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level**
24 **shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
25 **Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH**
27 **day of AUGUST, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,015.3 FOR;**
28 **~~0~~ AGAINST; ~~0~~ NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
30 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
31 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
32 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**




