

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office FY 2015 TERO
Administration West Valley Resort Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 15-335

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tribal Employment Rights Office**
2 **since 1978; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the continued operations of the Tribal Employment Rights Office is to increase**
4 **employment of Indians on and near the Tohono O'odham Nation by enforcing**
5 **Indian Preference in employment, training, contracting, sub-contracting, and**
6 **eradicate employment discrimination within the exterior boundaries of the**
7 **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has begun the process of constructing the new West**
9 **Valley Casino and Resort in Glendale; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the funding for the Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Employment Rights Office for**
11 **the TERO Administration West Valley Resort Budget will be supplemented by the**
12 **TERO Commission Revenue Fund in the amount of \$278,456.46; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Department Committee has reviewed this budget and**
14 **recommends its approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
16 **Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Office FY 2015 TERO Administration**
17 **West Valley Resort Budget in the amount of \$278,456.46, which shall be funded**
18 **by the TERO Commission Revenue Fund; provided that any funds unexpended in**
19 **FY 2015 may be expended in FY 2016 in accordance with the FY 2015 TERO**
20 **Administration West Valley Resort Budget.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**
22 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget,**
23 **as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding**
24 **levels of the budget shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono**
25 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21ST**
27 **day of AUGUST, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,635.0 FOR;**
28 **180.6 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 205.8 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
29 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)(3) and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
30 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the**
31 **Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**
32 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


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
