

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services'
Grant Application to the United States Department of Health and Human
Services, Indian Health Services, Division of Behavioral Health,
Domestic Violence Prevention
Initiative)**

RESOLUTION NO. 15-337

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council
2 with the authority to "promote, protect and provide a public health, peace,
3 moral, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its
4 members" and to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contract on
5 behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local
6 governments" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and (f)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the prevention of domestic violence including family violence, teen dating
8 violence, stalking and sexual assault is a priority for the Tohono O'odham
9 Nation which as enacted resolutions to that effect including but not limited to,
10 resolutions approving and accepting the grant from the Office on Violence
11 Against Women FY2009 (Resolution No. 09-0572, Resolution No. 09-599); and

12 **WHEREAS,** in response to a requirement of the Indian Health Services, Division of
13 Behavioral Health Domestic Violence Prevention Initiative, Funding
14 Announcement Number HHS-2015-IHS-DVPI-0001, a signed Tribal resolution is
15 required from all Tribes served by the project and must accompany the
16 electronic application submission; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services is
18 preparing a grant application requesting \$99,500.00 for the first year of the five-
19 year funding cycle from the Indian Health Service, Division of Behavioral Health
20 Domestic Violence Prevention Initiative to support the Tohono O'odham Kom
21 Ckud Ki: (Safe House) Program. The scope of work would focus on DVPI Purpose
22 Area 1: Domestic and Sexual Violence Prevention, Advocacy, and Coordinated
23 Community Responses; and

24 **WHEREAS,** the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees
25 recommends the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council support the Department
26 of Health and Human Services' grant application.
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1 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it**
2 **supports Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services' grant**
3 **application for the Indian health Service, Domestic Violence Prevention**
4 **Initiative grant; providing that any grant award and associated budget shall be**
5 **subject to approval by Legislative Council resolution pursuant to Resolution No.**
6 **99-059, "Approving a Process for Grant Fund Applications by the Executive**
7 **Branch".**

8 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21ST**
9 **day of AUGUST, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,815.6 FOR;**
10 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 205.8 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
11 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
12 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting**
13 **Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section**
14 **16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
