

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services' Grant
Application to the United States Department of Health and Human Services,
Indian Health Service, Division of Behavioral Health, Methamphetamine
Suicide Prevention Initiative)**

RESOLUTION NO. 15-338

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council**
2 **with the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace,**
3 **moral, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its**
4 **members and to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contract on**
5 **behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local**
6 **governments" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and (f)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the prevention of suicide and substance use, including alcohol,**
8 **methamphetamine and other substances, is a health priority for the Tohono**
9 **O'odham Nation which has enacted resolutions to that effect, including, but not**
10 **limited to, resolutions approving and accepting the Methamphetamine and**
11 **Suicide Prevention Initiative (MSPI) grant award since FY2009; (Resolution No.**
12 **09-488, Resolution No. 09-489); and**

13 **WHEREAS, in response to a requirement of the Indian Health Services, Division of**
14 **Behavioral Health, Methamphetamine Suicide Prevention Initiative, Funding**
15 **Announcement Number HHS-2015-IHS-MSPI-0001, a signed Tribal resolution is**
16 **required from all Tribes served by the project and must accompany the**
17 **electronic application submission; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Department of Health and Human Services is**
19 **preparing a grant application requesting \$112,500.00 for the first year of the**
20 **five-year funding cycle from the Indian Health Service, Division of Behavioral**
21 **Health, Methamphetamine Suicide Prevention Initiative to support the Tohono**
22 **O'odham Wecij Hemajkam Apedak (Youth Wellness) Project. The proposed**
23 **scope of work is focused on MSPI Purpose Area 4: Generation Indigenous**
24 **Initiative Support, to work with Native youth ages 8-24 years old to promote early**
25 **intervention strategies and implement positive youth development**
26 **programming to reduce risk factors for suicidal behaviors, methamphetamine**
27 **and other substance use; and**

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1 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and the Budget and Finance Committees**
2 **recommend the Council support the Department of Health and Human Services'**
3 **grant application.**

4 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it**
5 **supports Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services' grant**
6 **application for the Indian Health Service, Methamphetamine Suicide**
7 **Prevention Initiative grant; providing that any grant award and associated**
8 **budget shall be subject to approval by Legislative Council resolution pursuant to**
9 **Resolution No. 99-059, "Approving a Process for Grant Fund Applications by the**
10 **Executive Branch".**

11 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 21ST**
12 **day of AUGUST, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,815.6 FOR;**
13 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 205.8 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the**
14 **Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2), (c)(2) and (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
15 **Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the**
16 **Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to**
17 **Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
