

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2016 U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented
Policing Services Hiring Program Budget for grant no. 2013-UM-WX-0010)**

RESOLUTION NO. 15-358

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) applied for and was awarded the U.S.**
2 **Department of Justice (DOJ), Community Oriented Policing Service (COPS)**
3 **Hiring Program Grant No. 2013-UM-WX-0010 with an effective date of September**
4 **1, 2015 through August 31, 2016; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the grant was accepted by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by**
6 **Resolution No. 14-062; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department has prepared FY 2016 budget for**
8 **approval; and**

9 **WHEREAS, this grant requires a match that has been identified in the Tohono O'odham**
10 **Nation's Police Department's FY 2016 Tribal Law Enforcement Budget; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the three (3) Police Officer position's salary will be cost shared with the Law**
12 **Enforcement Tribal budget at 49.19% and 50.81% with the COPS Hiring Grant;**
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, this grant does not allow for Indirect Cost; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative**
16 **Council have reviewed this Budget and recommends its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
18 **approves the FY 2016 U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing**
19 **Services Hiring Program Budget for grant no. 2013-UM-WX-0010 in the amount**
20 **of \$125,000.00; effective September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016 with no**
21 **Indirect Cost and a salary cost share of 49.19% with the FY 2016 Tribal Law**
22 **Enforcement Budget and 50.81% with the COPS Hiring Grant.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
24 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
25 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level is**
26 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**


