12		positions at 50.8 1 % to be covered by the DOJ COPS Hiring Program and 49.19%
13		by the Tribal Law Enforcement budget; and
14	WHEREAS,	allowing the salary cost split of four (4) new Police Officer Positions at 35.33% to
15		be covered by DOJ COPS Hiring Program Homeland Security Grant and 64.67%
16		by the Tribal Law Enforcement budget; and
17	WHEREAS,	the amendment will adjust the salary of one (1) Police Officer position; and
18	WHEREAS,	there will be no changes to the approved budgeted amount; and
19	WHEREAS,	Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative Council
20		have reviewed this budget and recommends its approval.
21	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby
22		approves the FY 2016 Tribal Law Enforcement budget amendment #1 that:
23		1. Approves the salary cost split for the three (3) Police Officer positions
24		under the COPS Hiring Program Grant #2013UMWX0010 at 50.81% and
25		49.19% for the Tribal Law Enforcement budget.
26		2. Approves the salary cost share for the four (4) Police Officer positions
27		under the COPS Hiring Program Grant #2014UMWX0024 at 35.33% and
28		64.67% for the Tribal Law Enforcement budget.
