

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2016 Solid Waste Management Program Supplemental Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 15-361

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste**
2 **Management Program (SWMP) is an essential program that has been collecting,**
3 **recycling and disposing of the Nation's solid waste since 1998; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the SWMP's responsibilities have increased over time to collect and dispose of**
5 **illegal migrant and smuggler waste, close 122 community dumpsites, provide**
6 **emergency response and other heavy equipment services as needed which**
7 **benefit the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's leaders support replacing aging solid waste**
9 **management equipment to assure reliable solid waste and recycling collection**
10 **services, reduce maintenance costs and improve equipment safety; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the SWMP needs to purchase two new front loader trash trucks and two new**
12 **pick-up trucks for approximately \$596,400.00 to assure reliable solid waste and**
13 **recycling services; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the program has identified \$367,589.40 from the SWMP's Revenue Accounts and**
15 **requesting \$228,810.60 from General Fund Surplus to fund the capital**
16 **equipment expenditure; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the one-time capital budget of \$596,400.00 has been reviewed by the Agricultural**
18 **and Natural Resources and the Budget and Finance Committees of the**
19 **Legislative Council and they recommend its approval.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts and**
21 **approves FY 2016 Solid Waste Management Program Supplemental Budget from**
22 **SWMP's program revenue accounts and from General Fund Surplus for the**
23 **capital expenditure to purchase two front loader trash trucks and two pick-up**
24 **trucks for the Solid Waste Management to be expended in accordance with the**
25 **budget attached hereto.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
27 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the Budget as**
28 **attached, provided that any Amendments affecting the funds or funding levels is**
29 **submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
30 **Council.**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16TH day of SEPTEMBER, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(2)(d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
