1	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 14-566 the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") agreed to a
2		settlement with the Indian Health Service to settle claims for Contract Support
3		Costs incurred in fiscal year 2006-2010 in the amount of \$530,000; and
4	WHEREAS,	the settlement amount increased to \$555,798.71 due to added interest, and was
5		paid to the Nation in July 2015; and
6	WHEREAS,	the Nation has utilized \$144,000 of that amount to fund the attorney contract
7		with the law firm of Sonosky Chambers Sachse Miller & Munson, LLP, leaving a
8		remainder of \$411,798.71; and
9	WHEREAS,	it is in the Nation's best interest to dedicate the remainder of the Indian Health
10		Service settlement identified above to future costs related to negotiating and
11		implementing a self-governance compact with the Indian Health Service for
12		operation of the Sells Service Unit; and
13	WHEREAS,	this matter has been reviewed by the Health and Human Services and the Budget
14		and Finance Committees, which recommend approval by the Legislative
15		Council.
16	NOW, THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council amends
17		Resolution No. 14-566 to add the following additional Resolved clause:
18		BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
19		dedicates the settlement funds derived from the Settlement Agreement with the
20		Indian Health Service on Contract Support Costs from fiscal years 2006 through
21		2010 to the Nation's efforts to assume the program, functions, services and
22		activities currently performed by the Indian Health Service for the benefit of the
23		Nation.
