6	WHEREAS,	Indian Health Service has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the four (4
7		most critical projects and does allocate points impacting upon overal
8		prioritization of projects; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided
10		recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council regarding the
11		most critical needs.

13		reviewed and approved the entire priority list and has determined that the
14		following deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending
15		order of prioritization:

17		2. Sells Sewer Main/Lagoon Upgrade Phase 1
18		3. Sells Sewer Main/Lagoon Upgrade Phase 2
19		4. Undocumented Migrants (UDM) Clean-up (Scattered)
