

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adopting October 2015 Legislative Rules Amendments)**

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 15-398

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Legislative Council with the power to establish rules and procedures to regulate**
3 **all meetings of the Council and its standing committees (Constitution of the**
4 **Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has exercised this power by adopting and amending the**
6 **Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative**
7 **Rules"), which include the process for recording the proceedings of the**
8 **Legislative Council sessions and for the processing and presentation of**
9 **legislative actions to the Nation's chairperson; and**

10 **WHEREAS, it is in the Legislative Council's best interest to amend Legislative Rules Article 1**
11 **- Legislative Calendar, Article V - Minutes and Article IX - Processing and**
12 **Presentation of Legislative Actions to the Nation's Chairperson; Veto Process,**
13 **and to add a new Article III, Section 3 - Announcements, in accordance with the**
14 **attached Legislative Rules amendments dated for reference October 2015.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it adopts**
16 **the Legislative Rules amendments as dated for reference October 2015.**

17 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 14TH day of**
18 **OCTOBER, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,572.9 FOR; 219.9**
19 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 228.6[08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**
20 **by Article VI, Section 1(a) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
21 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
22 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
23 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
