**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 15-398**

3		all meetings of the Council and its standing committees (Constitution of the
4		Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(a)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council has exercised this power by adopting and amending the
6	,	Legislative Rules of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative
7		
•		Rules"), which include the process for recording the proceedings of the
8		Legislative Council sessions and for the processing and presentation of
9		legislative actions to the Nation's chairperson; and
10	WHEREAS,	it is in the Legislative Council's best interest to amend Legislative Rules Article 1
11		- Legislative Calendar, Article V - Minutes and Article IX - Processing and
12		Presentation of Legislative Actions to the Nation's Chairperson; Veto Process,
13		and to add a new Article III, Section 3 - Announcements, in accordance with the
14		attached Legislative Rules amendments dated for reference October 2015.
15	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it adopts
16		the Legislative Rules amendments as dated for reference October 2015.
