(Approval of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Immigration and
Customs Enforcement (ICE) and the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department for the
Reimbursement of Joint Operations Expenses from the Treasury Forfeiture Fund)

RESOLUTION NO. 15-446

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department is the governing body of the**
2 **Native American Targeted Investigations of Violent Enterprise (NATIVE) Task**
3 **Force, which was approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
4 **resolution #12-440; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), Homeland Security**
6 **Investigations (HSI) is part of the NATIVE Task Force and works continuous joint**
7 **investigations and operations with the Police Department; and**

8 **WHEREAS, ICE has reimbursement funds available for reimbursement of joint operations**
9 **through the U.S. Treasury Forfeiture Fund; and**

10 **WHEREAS, these funds will reimburse the Tohono O'odham Nation's Police Department**
11 **pay for overtime expenses of Police Officers working these joint operations; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department has detectives dedicated to full**
13 **time participation in the joint task force; and**

14 **WHEREAS, this agreement also allows the Tohono O'odham Nation to seek reimbursement**
15 **from ICE for other investigative expenses, such as travel and training or other**
16 **similar costs incurred by detectives assigned as designated members of the**
17 **joint operation; and**

18 **WHEREAS, law enforcement reimbursement requests can be submitted at least bi-weekly**
19 **to the ICE/HSI Special Agent in Charge, Phoenix; and**

20 **WHEREAS, Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees of the Legislative Council**
21 **have reviewed this MOU and recommend its approval.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
23 **approves the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Immigration and**
24 **Customs Enforcement (ICE) and the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department**
25 **for the Reimbursement of Joint Operations Expenses from the Treasury**
26 **Forfeiture Fund, and authorizes the Chairman to execute the MOU.**

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
28 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the funds**






