

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Delegating Authority to Enter a Joint Project Agreement Between the San Xavier
District and the Arizona Department of Transportation and Approving a Limited
Waiver of the San Xavier District's Sovereign Immunity for the San Xavier Road
Pathway Project)**

RESOLUTION NO. 15-458

1 **WHEREAS, the SAN XAVIER DISTRICT has been approved to receive Federal Transportation**
2 **Enhancement funding through the Arizona Department of Transportation**
3 **(ADOT) and the Regional Transportation Authority (RTA) for the design review,**
4 **scoping and construction of the project named San Xavier Road Pedestrian**
5 **Pathway, at a projected cost of \$453,000; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Transportation Enhancement program is administered by the Federal**
7 **Highway Administration (FHWA) and application is made to ADOT through the**
8 **Pima Association of Governments (PAG), in which an Agreement is entered into**
9 **between ADOT and the District; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the District has negotiated an Agreement denominated JPA 11-009-I attached**
11 **hereto, using ADOT's standard form of Intergovernmental Agreement which**
12 **calls for dispute resolution by arbitration, with a limited waiver of the District's**
13 **sovereign immunity in connection with that procedure; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council must give approval to the District to**
15 **include a limited waiver of the District's sovereign immunity in any contract to**
16 **which the District is a party; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council, in its Resolution 10-15-5, requests approval from**
18 **the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council to waive its sovereign immunity as**
19 **limited by the terms of the JPA; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did approve in Legislative Council**
21 **Resolution Number 12-487 dated 11 December 2012 an earlier version of the**
22 **Intergovernmental Agreement between ADOT and the San Xavier District**
23 **concerning this same project, which Agreement included a limited waiver of the**
24 **District's sovereign immunity substantially similar to that in JPA 11-009-I; and**

25 **WHEREAS, this matter has been reviewed by the Legislative Agricultural and Natural**
26 **Resources Committee, which recommends that the Legislative Council confirm**
27 **San Xavier District's authority to enter into the JPA.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

- 1. The Nation approves a limited waiver of the District's sovereign immunity to support the dispute resolution and indemnification provisions in the Joint Project Agreement JPA 11-009-I between the San Xavier District and ADOT for the design review, scoping and construction of the project named San Xavier Road Pedestrian Pathway, which the District is hereby authorized to enter.**
- 2. The Tohono O'odham Nation is not waiving the District's right to assert the defense of sovereign immunity except as expressly set forth, referred to, and provided for, in this resolution.**

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that nothing in this resolution shall be construed as a waiver of the sovereign immunity of the Tohono O'odham Nation and any responsibility and liability, including financial liability, related to this project and the Agreement, shall remain with San Xavier District, and no responsibility or liability including financial liability shall fall upon the Tohono O'odham Nation.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 18TH day of NOVEMBER, 2015 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
