3		general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members" and to
4		"consult with the Congress of the United States and appropriate federal agencies
5		regarding federal activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation"
6		(Constitution, Article VI, Section (1(c)(2) and Article VI, Section 1(j)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Nation's written comments to federal, state and local governments on laws
8		and rules proposed by those entities must be approved by the Legislative
9		Council (1 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 3, Section 3102); and
10	WHEREAS,	the Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System ("AHCCCS") is a Medicaid
11		"demonstration project" under Section 1115 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
12		§1315); and
13	WHEREAS,	AHCCCS's status as a demonstration project allows the Secretary of Health and
14		Human Services to waive certain statutory requirements that would normally
15	:	apply to state Medicaid plans; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Arizona State Legislature recently enacted two laws, SB 1092 and SB 1475,
17		requiring certain provisions be included in Arizona's September 30, 2015
18	0	Demonstration Waiver Proposal ("Proposal") including a lifetime limit of five
19		years for able-bodied adults, a moratorium on non-emergency medical
20		transportation, and the imposition of work requirements; and
21	WHEREAS,	while the Nation already opposed by resolution the provisions of SB 1092 which
22		harm Nation's members, it is in the best interest of the Nation to also submit
23	s.	"Tohono O'odham Nation Comments to Arizona's September 30, 2015 Section
24		1115 Demonstration Waiver," which are incorporated by this reference (Tohono
25		O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 15-233; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the "Tohono O'odham
27		Nation Comments to Arizona's September 30, 2015 Section 1115 Demonstration
28		Waiver" and recommend approval.
