RESOLUTION NO. 15-482

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation applied for and was awarded the U. S. Department**
2 **of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Sex Offender Sentencing,**
3 **Monitoring, Apprehending, Registering and Tracking Office, Enhance the Sex**
4 **Offender Registration, Tracking, Enforcement and Notification Division, SORNA**
5 **Program, Award No. 2015-AW-BX-0011; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the grant period is effective October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2017; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department has prepared an FY 2016 budget**
8 **as attached; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Indirect Cost is waived until an Indirect Cost Rate Agreement is negotiated**
10 **and approved and applicable to the grant's performance period; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and the Budget and Finance Committees of the Tohono**
12 **O'odham Legislative Council have reviewed this budget and recommends its**
13 **approval.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**
15 **accepts the U.S. DOJ, OJP, Sex Offender Sentencing, Monitoring, Apprehending,**
16 **Registering and Tracking Office, Enhance the Sex Offender Registration,**
17 **Tracking, Enforcement and Notification Division, SORNA Program, with an**
18 **effective date of October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2017 and approves the**
19 **FY 2016 budget in the amount of \$154,843.63 with no Indirect Cost Charges until**
20 **an Indirect Cost Rate Agreement is negotiated and approved.**

21 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**
22 **Tohono O'odham Nation Police Department to expend the funds from the**
23 **attached FY 2016 budget for the period of October 1, 2015 through September 30,**
24 **2016, on a reimbursement basis and to utilize the Nation's resources pending**
25 **reimbursement from the Grantor for the continuation of this grant.**

26 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby authorizes**
27 **the Chairman and any designated official to expend and administer the budget**
28 **as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level**
