15		accordance with Title 7 CFR Subpart 246.6(a) is required to enter into a signed
16		written agreement with each Agency that sets forth the local agency's
17		responsibilities for program operations as prescribed in Title 7 CFR Subpart
18		246.6 (b); and
19	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has continued to serve as the local WIC Agency
20		which has successfully operated the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program
21		for Women, Infants and Children; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee have reviewed the MOA between
23		ITCA and the Nation and recommends it's approval.
