

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the FY 2016 Veterans Affairs Budget Amendment #1)

RESOLUTION NO. 16-034

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution #15-165, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved the**
2 **FY 2016 Veterans Affairs Office budget in the amount of \$117,976.31; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the program projects and services have changed and there is a need to modify**
4 **budget amounts to cover program expenses by adding a line item to meet**
5 **projected needs per the attached budget amendment; and**

6 **WHEREAS, a new line item 4850 — Donations and Contributions with an amount of \$500 in**
7 **initial received donations was added which will be used to help subsidize**
8 **program costs and expenses and support veteran related-events and projects;**
9 **and**

10 **WHEREAS, the total budget will increase by \$500 from \$117,976.31 to \$118,476.31 due to the**
11 **receipt of \$500 in donations with no change in the amount of general fund**
12 **dollars allocated to this budget; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Veterans Affairs Office has modified the FY 2016 Performance Criteria and**
14 **goals to reflect more appropriate and viable program service related activities**
15 **with quantifiable performance measurement outcomes as stated in the**
16 **attached proposed amendment; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and the Budget and Finance Committees of**
18 **the Legislative Council have reviewed this budget amendment and recommend**
19 **its approval.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**

21 **(1) Creates a revenue account for donations, contributions, revenues, and**
22 **sponsorships to the Veterans Affairs Office, which shall be expended in**
23 **accordance with budgets approved by Legislative Council resolution; and**

24 **(2) Approves the FY 2016 Veterans Affairs Budget Amendment #1 to add a**
25 **new line item 4850- Donations and Contributions with an amount of**
26 **\$500 in initial received donations which will be used to help subsidize**
27 **program costs and expenses and support veteran related events and**
28 **projects in the amount of \$118,476.31 in accordance with the attached**
29 **budget.**

1 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
2 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget as**
3 **attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding level**
4 **shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham**
5 **Legislative Council.**

6 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH**
7 **day of JANUARY, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR;**
8 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
9 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**
10 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
11 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of**
12 **June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
