1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") vests the Legislative
2		Council with the power to enact laws "to promote, protect and provide for public
3	ł	health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham
4		Nation and its members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council established the Tohono O'odham Ki:Ki Association
6		("TOKA") as a separate tribal entity in accordance with Article VI of the
7		Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and pursuant to Legislative Council
8		Ordinance No. 98-03, as amended (TOKA Ordinance No. 98-03, 18 Tohono
9		O'odham Code Chapter 1); and
10	WHEREAS,	the TOKA is (1) designated as the Nation's "Tribally Designated Housing Entity"
11		("TDHE") in accordance with the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-
12		Determination Act of 1996, 25 U.S.C. §4101, et seq., P.L. 104-330, 110 Stat. 4106
13		("NAHASDA") to implement the Nation's Indian Housing Plan under NAHASDA's
14		Indian Housing Block Grant ("IHBG") Program, and (2) established for the
15		primary purpose of providing well constructed and affordable homes for the
16		members, as well as maintaining the current assisted stock of home ownership
17		and rental homes (TOKA Ordinance Statement of Purpose and Article I.1.); and
18	WHEREAS	the Nation and each of the Nation's Districts are desirons of undertaking
19		community development activities; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Conncil acknowledges that housing is an
21		integral part of community development of the Nation and its Districts and that
22		all of the Nation's and each of its District's community members should have
23		access to safe and affordable housing; and
24	WHEREAS,	pursuant to 24 CFR Part 58, the United States Department of Housing and Urban
25		Development ("HUD") Environmental Review requirements require an
26		authorized tribal official to execute HUD Form 7015.15 "Request for Release of
27		Funds and Certification" which consents to suit in Federal District Court

1		regarding compliance with the National Environmental Protection Act ("NEPA")					
2		in carrying out HUD grants; and					
3	WHEREAS,	TOKA, as a recipient of federal and from time to time, state funds, in order to					
4		receive draw-downs on such federal and/or state funds for project					
5		implementation, (1) a certifying tribal official for the Nation must execute HUD					
6		Form 7015.15 "Request for Release of Funds and Certification;" and (2) TOKA					
7		must comply with NAHASDA and other program guidelines and federal statutes					
8		and regulations; including but not limited to, those related to the federal					
9	government's NEPA review/assessment process applicable to the use an						
10	expenditure of federal grant funds for low-income housing projects (24 CFR 50						
11		and 24 CFR 85); and					
12	WHEREAS,	pursuant to TOLC Resolution 14-251, the TOLC designated and authorized the					
13		TOKA Executive Director as the Nation's "Certifying Officer" for and on behalf of					
14		the Nation to (1) certify the TOKA's satisfaction of and compliance with the					
15		TOKA's responsibilities in relation to the federal government's NEPA					
16		environmental review process applicable to the TOKA'S receipt, use and					
17		expenditure of (a) federal and state housing grant funds; (b) proceeds of					
18		federally guaranteed loan programs; and (c) financing proceeds from federal					
19		and/or state low-income tax credit programs; (2) execute any documents					
20		required or as may be reasonably necessary to implement the intent of TOLC					
21		Resolution 14-251, including HUD Form 7015.15 "Request for Release of Funds					
22		and Certification" for federal and state housing funds; and (3) consent to and					
23		accept on behalf of TOKA, the jurisdiction of the federal courts for the limited					
24		purpose of enforcing federal regulatory responsibilities arising from and					
25		compliance with the federal government's environmental review/assessment					
26		process related and applicable to TOKA'S receipt, use and expenditure of federal					
27 20		and state housing funds; and					
28	WHEREAS,	HUD has informed TOKA of its position that (1) the Nation is the actual recipient					
29		of the Nation's NAHASDA funds allocated to the Nation even though the Nation

1		has a separate TDHE; (2) the Nation still is the Responsible Entity for the
2		oversight and other responsibilities, as a federally-recognized Tribe, with
3		respect to federal grant funds and compliance with the federal government's
4		NEPA review/assessment and compliance process and that such oversight and
5		responsibilities cannot be delegated to TOKA, as the Nation's TDHE; and (3) thus,
6		the Chairman or other formally authorized member of a Tribe's governing body
7		must assume the role of Certifying Officer/Responsible Federal Official for the
8		Responsible Entity for NEPA review/assessment and compliance purposes; and
9	WHEREAS,	it is in the best interests of the Nation that in order to be in compliance with the
10		Nation's oversight and other responsibilities, as a federally-recognized Tribe,
11		with respect to federal grant funds and compliance with the federal
12		government's NEPA review/assessment and compliance process, to (1) repeal
13		TOLC Resolution 14-251; (2) designate, approve and authorize the Nation's
14		Chairman as the Certifying Officer for the TOKA with respect to federal and state
15		grant funds and compliance with the federal government's NEPA
16		review/assessment and compliance requirements; and (3) consent to and accept
17		on behalf of the Nation, the jurisdiction of the federal courts if an action is
18		brought to enforce the TOKA's responsibilities and compliance in relation to the
19		federal NEPA review/assessment and compliance process.
20	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,
21		notwithstanding any contrary provision of TOKA Ordinance 98-03, hereby
22		1. repeals TOLC Resolution 14-251;
23		2. designates and authorizes the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation
24		as the "Certifying Officer," as that term is defined in 24 CFR § 58.2(a)(2),
25		for and on behalf of the TOKA, to:
26		A. consent to and accept on behalf of the TOKA, the jurisdiction of
27		the federal courts for the limited purpose of enforcement of the
28		federal regulatory responsibilities arising from and compliance
29		with the federal government's NEPA review/assessment process

6	environmental review process applicable to the TOKA's receipt,
7	use and expenditure of federal and state housing grant funds; and
8	3. execute any documents required or necessary as may be reasonably
9	necessary to implement the intent of this resolution, including the
10	execution of HUD Form 7015.15 "Request for Release of Funds and
11	Certification".
12	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29 TH
13	day of JANUARY, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,021.4 FOR;
14	<u>-Q-</u> AGAINST; <u>-Q-</u> NOT VOTING; and [<u>Q3</u>] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
15	Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the
16	Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
17	Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
18	June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
