Roads Discretionary Funds)**

RESOLUTION NO. 16-046

1 **WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department's Roads Program**
2 **Discretionary Funds are part of the BIA 638 Master Contract as approved by**
3 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 11-535; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved FY 2016 budget for the**
5 **Planning and Economic Development Department's Road Discretionary**
6 **Program by Resolution No. 15-167; and**

7 **WHEREAS, Budget Amendment No. 1 will create line items 7020 Kitchen Supplies, 7035**
8 **Building Materials, 7100 Utilities, 7420 RM Building, and 7430 RM Grounds; and**

9 **WHEREAS, Budget Amendment No. 1 will adjust the Operational Expense line items to**
10 **create new Operational Expense line items and increase the Indirect cost to**
11 **\$20,833.77 thereby increasing the total budget from \$214,785.05 to \$220,910.05;**
12 **and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Natural Resources and the Budget and Finance Committees**
14 **of the Legislative Council have reviewed this Budget Amendment and**
15 **recommend its approval.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
17 **approves the FY-2016 Roads Discretionary Funds Program Budget Amendment**
18 **No. 1 as attached hereto:**

- 19 **1. Approve adjusting Operational Expense line items to create new**
20 **Operational Expense line items 7020 Kitchen Supplies; 7035 Building**
21 **Materials; 7100 utilities; 7420 RM Building; and 7430 RM Grounds.**
- 22 **2. Approve the increase of the Indirect cost to \$20,833.77**
- 23 **3. Approve the increase of budget to \$220,910.05.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes the**
25 **Chairperson and any designated official to expend and administer the budget,**
26 **as attached, provided that any amendments affecting the funds or funding levels**
27 **is submitted for further prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
28 **Council.**
