RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Consenting to Renewal of the Western Area Power Administration Electrical Transmission Right-of-Way across the San Xavier District)

RESOLUTION NO. 16-053

1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,
2		negotiate, and conclude agreements on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation
3		("Nation") with the Federal, state, and local governments" (Constitution of the
4		Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f); and
5	WHEREAS,	Western Area Power Administration ("Western"), an agency of the US
6		Department of Energy, operates the Tucson-Apache 115kV transmission line
7		built in the 1950s and currently comprises wood H-frame and 3-pole turning
8		transmission structures and appurtenant facilities that runs from Western's
9		Tucson substation near Grant and Flowing Wells roads in Tucson, Arizona; and
10	WHEREAS,	a segment of this transmission line crosses the Tohono O'odham Nation in the
11		San Xavier District ("SXD") comprising 2.9 linear miles (52.870 acres) between
12		Los Reales Road and South Nogales Highway in Township 15 South, Range 13
13		East, Sections 23, 24, 25 and 36 of the Gila and Salt River Baseline and Meridian;
14		and
15	WHEREAS,	Western previously held a 100-foot ROW (50 feet on either side of centerline) in
16		the Project area; the current ROW application is for 150 feet of ROW (50 feet west
17		of centerline, 100 feet east of centerline) all of which crosses eleven allotments
18		in the northeast corner of San Xavier District (District) lands; and
19	WHEREAS,	in negotiations for renewal, Western has announced its intent to upgrade the
20		line's capacity to a double-circuit 230 kV transmission line comprised of tubular
21		steel monopoles; and
22	WHEREAS,	the term for Western's previous rights-of-way for the Tucson-Apache 115-kV
23		transmission line expired on March 26, 2000, and Western has requested a fifty-
24		eight year renewal of said rights-of-way; and
25	WHEREAS,	the Nation has acquired fractional interests in a number of allotments crossed
26		by Western's 115-kV electrical transmission line; and
27	WHEREAS,	the District procured an appraisal of the present value of a renewal of Western's
28		right of way, and Western has agreed to compensation totaling \$3,500,000

(Consenting to Renewal of the Western Area Power Administration Electrical Transmission Rightof-Way across the San Xavier District) Page 2 of 3 payable in one lump sum for a 58 year easement, and including rent for the 1 2 period of trespass, which is consistent with that appraisal; and 3 Western has given notice to the affected landowners according to the WHEREAS. 4 requirements of the Bureau of Indian Affairs, of the terms of its offer for the 5 renewed right of way; and the Bureau of Indian Affairs has advised the District that a majority of interest 6 WHEREAS. holders, other than the Tohono O'odham Nation, has now consented to the 7 renewal of Western's electrical transmission rights-of-way across the allotted 8 9 lands of the District: and the Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee recommends approval by 10 WHEREAS. the Legislative Council. 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby believes 12 it is in the best interest of the landowners to accept the present offer and grant 13 Western a renewal of its right of way according to the terms of the proposed 14 15 application for Grant of Easement attached hereto.
