

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriating \$300,062.48 from the General Fund Surplus to the Ha:sañ
Preparatory and Leadership School)

RESOLUTION NO. 16-056

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council**
2 **with the power to appropriate Nation's funds "for the benefit of the [N]ation and**
3 **its members" and to provide laws "to promote, protect and provide for public**
4 **health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham**
5 **Nation and its members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and 1(c)(2); and**

6 **WHEREAS, since 1998, Ha:sañ Preparatory and Leadership School ("Ha:sañ School"), a**
7 **bicultural Charter School in Tucson, Arizona, has prepared Tohono O'odham**
8 **and other Native American students for college or other post-high school**
9 **education, with a long-term commitment to the Tohono O'odham cultural**
10 **language and education; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Ha:sañ School has been affected by financial challenges and finds it**
12 **necessary to seek financial assistance from the Nation to sustain the school's**
13 **current level of services through the end of the current school year; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Ha:sañ School has prepared and submitted for review and approval "A**
15 **Proposal for School Funding to Support Bicultural Education for Native**
16 **American Students," in the amount of \$300,062.48, including (1) \$182,564.98 for**
17 **Instructional Expenses, (2) \$61,001.50 for Special Education Student Support**
18 **Expenses, and (3) \$56,496.00 for Transportation Expenses to fund current level of**
19 **services through the end of the 2015-2016 school year; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee and Budget and Finance**
21 **Committee have reviewed the proposal from the Ha:sañ Preparatory and**
22 **Leadership School and recommend its approval.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves a**
24 **one-time appropriation of \$300,062.48 from the FY 2016 general fund surplus to**
25 **Ha:sañ Preparatory and Leadership School in accordance with the attached**
26 **Donation Budget; provided that Ha:sañ Preparatory and Leadership School**
27 **shall provide the Legislative Council and Nation's chairperson written reports**
28 **every six months for two years on the expenditures of funds appropriated by this**
29 **resolution and the School's progress in gaining financial stability and the**
30 **School's audits for FY 2015-2017.**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10th day of FEBRUARY, 2016 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,484.2 FOR; 1,170.0 AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and 367.2 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
